## PLAYER & PARENT INFORMATION

Please take the time to read through the following information.

*For many of you this will be your first major tournament, please be aware that this will be a very busy weekend of squash and players will be playing numerous matches on both days. We are unable to delay, move or re-schedule matches at a tournament this size so please be aware of how many matches you will need to play each day and at what times. Help from ESR Staff and the Tournament Desk is always available so please check with us if you have any questions or queries relating to match times and the draw. We hope you have a fantastic tournament and wish you the best of luck!*

- ✓ ALL players must wear approved eye protection at all times when on court, this includes solo practice and warming up. A list of approved eye protection can be found on [www.englishsquashandracketball.com](http://www.englishsquashandracketball.com).
- ✓ All players will have an opportunity to have a hit on the spectacular all glass Showcourt at the National Centre, please note black balls are not permitted on this court and a white ball should be asked for at the Tournament Desk.
- ✓ ALL players must sign in at the Tournament Desk 30 minutes prior to their match, you need to check in for each match you play.
- ✓ Each match has a scheduled start time, please be ready to play and be by the side of your allocated court at your specific start time, should matches overrun you need to be ready to play as soon as the previous match on your court ends.
- ✓ We are using the Monrad draw for this event, this means you carry on playing each round even if you lose! Please check at the Tournament Desk for your future matches. This weekend has a very busy schedule, please note matches cannot be delayed or re-scheduled.
- ✓ Each player will receive a packed lunch voucher each day which they can exchange with the café. The café will be open throughout the weekend from 9am til 5pm offering a variety of hot and cold food, anyone wishing to purchase food or drinks outside of these times must use the vending machines available in reception.
- ✓ PAR scoring to 11 will be used for the Championships.
- ✓ Player/Parent Conduct: We expect both players and parents to treat the Centre, Staff, Referees and each other with respect at all times. Please refer to the Player/Parent Code of Conduct, any behaviour that contravenes the code of conduct will be taken seriously and may result in a player being withdrawn from the tournament.
- ✓ We hope to have Official ESR referee's assigned to all matches at the tournament, parents may be asked to mark if necessary.
- ✓ Presentations will be made on the Showcourt after the last match has finished on Sunday afternoon. Trophies will be awarded for places 1-4, players involved are expected to stay.
- ✓ The decision of the Tournament Director is final on all matters.
